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Post Acute Care

Post Acute Care/Long Term Care has changed to more of a low to mid acuity healthcare facility – Not just your Mothers Nursing Home

Services – Rehabilitation, Memory Care, Nursing Home, In-Home, and some Outpatient

Post Acute Statistics

- Nursing Homes – 15,600
- Home Health Agencies – 12,400
- Nursing Homes providing services to almost 800,000 patients/residents
- Home Health providing services to 4.9 million patients
- Average Med's per patient – **11 unique prescribed medications**

Acute Statistics

- Hospitals – 5,560
- Staffed Beds – 898,000
- Occupancy Rate – 65% - 585,000 patients
